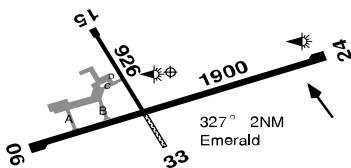

1. All C130 operations require prior approval and Pavement Concession.
2. No turns on THR RWY 33 during wet WX.
3. ACFT ABV 5,700 KG contact AD OPR for parking instructions.
4. ACFT BLW 5,700KG not permitted to park on main apron (Bay 1 to 6).
5. Security screened airport established. GA ACFT below 5,700KG are to use TWY off RWY 15/33 to access the GA apron during daylight HR.
6. Bird hazard may exist such as black kites. NOTAM will be raised during periods of increased activity.
7. Flying fox HN activity, transiting AD FM North to South across RWY 06/24.
8. Fruit bat activity occurs throughout the year. ARO monitors during dusk and alert over CTAF, if observed.
