Known History and Current Use of Place:

Current Use

Since the closure of the Transmitter Station, the place has been used for a small number of research and communication activities and routine maintenance of the existing assets are carried out.

<u>History</u>

The International Transmitter Station was placed on air on 10th March 1959, and represented one part of a complex network of ground communication stations, interconnected by radio or land line, with which aircraft could communicate throughout flight. Over the life of the station there were changes in equipment, buildings and aerials, but these are poorly documented. The station ceased transmitting in December 2005, with the advent of undersea cables and satellite communications replacing the use of HF radio. The Station was used to transmit Radio VNG Australia's standard time signal from 12th January 1993 to 31st December 2002. The time signal was used for purposes such as geophysical, navigation and surveying where precise knowledge of time was required. The radio service was replaced by other methods such as the use of GPS.
