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NEW PILBARA AREA CHART

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 This AIC is to provide notification to pilots and the aviation industry of the publication for the Pilbara Area Chart (as part of the TAC 8), the first chart will be effective 202112011600 UTC.

2. OPERATIONAL INFORMATION

- 2.1 The Office of Airspace Regulation (OAR) within CASA has conducted a review of the airspace within 100NM of Coondewanna Airport (YCWA). This area is referred to as the Pilbara Region. A recommendation from the review was the publication of a chart to raise awareness of operations in the airspace and enhance safety for IFR operations.
- 2.2 The area chart shows features and attributes similar to those published on a TAC, with the addition of the depiction of arrival and departure routes in and out of aerodromes in the Pilbara area as defined in *ERSA GEN-FPR*. Relevant instrument approach segments are also depicted on the chart.
