PERTH AERODROME (YPPH) TERMINAL 2 AIRFIELD PAVEMENT RENEWAL WORKS

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 This AIC cancels and replaces AIC H12/25 with changes to Sections 1.3, 1.5, 2.2, 5 and removal of Taxiway C restrictions in Section 3.
- 1.2 This AIC is to provide forward notification of the Terminal 2 airfield pavement renewals and surface treatment works. These works will be staged to minimise disruption to operators. This project is essential to extend the serviceable life of the airfield infrastructure.
- 1.3 All works disrupting aircraft operations will be advised via distribution of a Method of Working Plan (MOWP), which will be available via the Perth Airport website two weeks prior to the project commencement:

The MOWP will be also available at Perth Airport's Extranet under the Airfield Works section
- 1.4 The actual date and time of works will be advised by a NOTAM.
- 1.5 Pavement surface renewals are planned for:
 - 100mm asphalt renewal to Link 4 and Link 5
 - Structural strengthening of Bays 202 to 209 to include Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) and strip drain replacement
 - Strip drain replacement of Bay 201
 - 50mm or 100mm asphalt renewal to Bays 250 to 255
 - Fuel Resistant Membrane (FRM) for Bays 201 and 250 to 255

- Crack sealing and rejuvenation treatment
- Marking and lighting works

2. WORKS PROGRAM

- 2.1 The works will be undertaken in stages to minimise disruption to operators and distributed via a MOWP.
- 2.2 The works are expected to commence in late April 2025 and be completed by November 2025.
- 2.3 Aircraft parking bay closures for surface treatments will be coordinated with Perth Airport ACC.

3. OPERATIONAL INFORMATION

- 3.1 Normal scheduled A380 operations will be unaffected by these works.
- 3.2 Airfield ground lighting in the affected areas will be unavailable for portions of the works period within each individual stage.

- 5.1 This AIC will remain current until updated or all works are completed (expected November 2025).


