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## **PERTH AERODROME (YPPH) – CENTRAL DOMESTIC APRON EXPANSION (NEW AIRCRAFT PARKING POSITIONS)**

### **1. INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 This AIC is to provide forward notification of works for the construction of additional aircraft parking positions located at the Central Domestic Apron, including re-alignment of a number of existing aircraft parking positions which will deliver enhanced capacity for aircraft parking at Perth Aerodrome.
- 1.2 All works disrupting aircraft operations will be advised via distribution of a Method of Working Plan (MOWP), which will be available via the Perth Aerodrome website two weeks prior the project commencement:

- 1.3 The MOWP will be also available at Perth Aerodrome's Extranet under the Airfield Works section.
- 1.4 The actual date and time of works will be advised by a NOTAM.
- 1.5 The works to be carried out include:
  - Modification and expansion of existing drainage systems to accommodate additional Aircraft Parking Positions
  - Construction of new pavement for Aircraft Parking Positions 513 and 514
  - Slight realignment of Aircraft Parking Positions 509 to 512
  - Upgrade of apron floodlighting
  - Marking works.

## **2. WORKS PROGRAM**

- 2.1 The works will be undertaken in stages to minimise disruption to operators and distributed via a MOWP.
- 2.2 The works are expected to commence mid-February 2026 and be completed in September 2026.
- 2.3 Closures and restrictions of Aircraft Parking Positions during these works will be coordinated with Perth Aerodrome's Airport Control Centre (ACC).

## **3. OPERATIONAL INFORMATION**

- 3.1 Normal scheduled A380 operations will be unaffected by these works.
- 3.2 Closure of limited sections of Hotel Lane and 500 Lane are proposed between 2230 – 1030 UTC during some works stages, with closed areas being made available at the end of each shift until these works are completed.
