JERVIS BAY (NSW) TO BASS STRAIT
06 APRIL - 04 MAY 2026****1. INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 Elements of the Australian Defence Force will be conducting a military fleet exercise offshore from Jervis Bay (NSW) to the Bass Strait occurring 06 April to 04 May 2026
- 1.2 These activities will include an increase in maritime patrol aircraft and ship-borne rotary wing operations in support of Royal Australian Navy vessels.

2. AIRSPACE

- 2.1 Fixed and rotary wing operations will occur in Class G Airspace.
- 2.2 Due to the expected unpredictability of naval ship maneuvers and movements and the large expanse of area covered by the exercise, fidelity on specific operating locations of aviation activities cannot be provided at any given time during this period.

3. MILITARY AIRCRAFT OPERATIONS

3.1 Military aircraft will monitor, and when necessary, broadcast on the appropriate Area, CTAF, or Broadcast Area frequency relative to their location.

4. OTHER ACTIVITIES OF A DANGEROUS NATURE AND OTHER POTENTIAL HAZARDS – WARSHIPS

- 4.1 Australian warships will have embarked ACFT which may conduct aviation operations at any time.
- 4.2 In order to maintain safe operations, pilots should avoid warships by 5NM laterally or not below 2,000FT vertically whenever possible, and should not circle a warship at any time.
- 4.3 Traffic alerts and warnings may be massed on FREQ 121.5 MHz to aircraft operating in the vicinity of warships.
- 4.4 Refer to *AIP ENR 5.3*.






