1 Name

This administrative decision is *Airservices Australia Air Traffic Control & Supporting Services Administrative Decision (Remuneration) 2023/01.*

2 Commencement

This administrative decision commences on the date it is signed.

3 Authority

This administrative decision is made under section 42 of the *Air Services Australia Act 1995*.

4 Application

This administrative decision applies to all employees at Airservices Australia covered by the *Enterprise Agreement*.

5 Definitions

In this administrative decision:

Employee(s) means the persons employed by Airservices Australia who are covered by the *Airservices Australia (Air Traffic Control and Supporting Air Traffic Services) Enterprise Agreement 2020-2023*.

Enterprise Agreement means the enterprise agreement approved by the Fair Work Commission on 14 April 2020 and known as the Airservices Australia (Air Traffic Control and Supporting Air Traffic Services) Enterprise Agreement 2020-2023.

6 Purpose

The purpose of this administrative decision is to provide employees with adjustments to their existing salary and to allowances for which they are eligible under the terms of the Enterprise Agreement.

7 Period of operation

This administrative decision is in force for the period:

- (a) beginning at the start of the day this administrative decision commences;
- (b) ending at the earlier of the following:
 - (i) the start of the day that an enterprise agreement made in accordance with the *Fair Work Act 2009* that covers the employees and replaces the Enterprise Agreement commences operation; or
 - (ii) the start of the day that another administrative decision under *Air Services Act 1995* that applies to the employees and expressly revokes this determination comes into force.

8 Adjustment of salary and allowances

- (1) Employees' salaries are adjusted by 3%, with effect on 21 April 2023.
- (2) The adjustment is to be calculated based on the salary immediately before the adjustment under subsection (1).
- (3) Travel, additional hours meal, additional motor vehicle, first aid, disturbance, district, remote locality, and representative allowances are adjusted by the same percentage as salaries, with effect on 21 April 2023.
- (4) Each adjustment of an allowance is to be calculated based on the allowance immediately before the adjustment under subsection (3).
- (5) Schedule 1 has effect.
